AZGFD --- Gill Netting Program

The Arizona Game and Fish Department has been setting gill nets from February 26 through March 7, 2008 in Rainbow Lake to remove northern pike. Northern pike are voracious eaters and have consumed many stocked rainbow trout as well as largemouth bass and sunfish. So far, 160 northern pike have been removed, including 2 21 pound female pike.
