2011 Outings and & Events...Ted Lambert, Outings Chairman

FEBRUARY OUTING - The Arizona Flycasters again invited us to their annual outing at Dead Horse Ranch State Park at Cottonwood. In spite of the frigid weather conditions, a few of us from our club traveled there for the weekend and had a good time.



The weekend began early Friday evening with "Happy Hour". Everyone contributed a snack of some kind and brought their drinks. Some very tasty dishes showed up. Among them were Alaskan smoked salmon, Alaskan smoked cod, jalapeño poppers, several cheeses with crackers, chips and salsa, chocolate covered blueberries, taquitos and guacamole.

There were three ponds at the park and Saturday morning found several of us there with our tubes. Most everyone caught a fish or two. Flies used were the Adams, KP Bugger, Beadhead Tailless Peacock Lady, Olive Green Woolly Bugger, Prince Nymph, Elk Hair Caddis and Brown Woolly Bugger.

Potluck was at 3:00 sharp that afternoon. Arizona Fly Casters provided hamburgers and hot dogs cooked on the grill, along with buns and condiments. Several side dishes showed up including potato casserole, potato salad, ranch beans, veggie tray, tortilla chips, 2 salsas, cold slaw and chicken. Desserts included cookies, brownies, chocolate cake, lemon pie, peach cobbler and cherry/rhubarb oatmeal crisp.

MARCH OUTING – Roosevelt Lake Grapevine Campground: March 25th - 27th, 2011, Special Joint Outing with Arizona Flycasters. Here is another opportunity for you to head to warmer climates for a few days and try your hand at hooking a Large Mouth Bass or Crappie or possibly a Small Mouth Bass on a fly. Those of you from the valley could make it there for a day trip or bring a trailer up for the weekend.

The Mallard Loop of the Grapevine Group Campground has been reserved for the outing. The campground has a nice group Ramada and restrooms with showers. The cost of camping will be \$15.00 for two nights and the cost of day use will be \$3.00 per car. The camping and day use fees will be collected by the camp host. A Tonto Daily Use Pass is required by each vehicle at Roosevelt Lake. The Tonto Daily Use Pass will be handed out by the camp host at the time you pay your camping and day use fees.

There is a boat launch near the group campground that can accommodate the launching of float tubes/pontoon boats as well as fishing boats. We are working on getting members with boats to transport fishers to some prime locations along with their float tubes or pontoons. You can also try your hand at traditional fishing (spin and bait casting) if you'd like. A 3 or 5 weight rod with full sink or sink tip lines will work just fine with Streamers, Crawdad imitations, Frog imitations, Woolly Buggers to start. The fish that you can expect to catch are Bass and Crappie, so bring your favorite fly's to entice these species of fish.

Plan on a Happy Hour early Friday evening and bring an appetizer afternoon and of course there will be a potluck on Saturday afternoon at 3PM, so bring your favorite dish (entrée, salad, or dessert). The pot luck is always a big hit at the AFC outing and it will lots of fun meeting up with the AFC members and their families. Project Healing Waters - Is dedicated to the physical and emotional rehabilitation of disabled active military service personnel and veterans through fly fishing and fly tying education and outings.

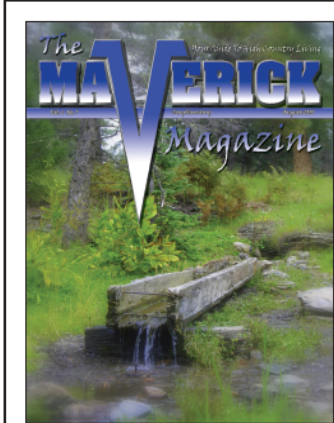
Annual Banquet-June 11, 2011 There are lots of different committees that you can sign up for.
